Here's a quick comparison between Squarespace and Webflow:

	<b>Squarespace</b>	<b>Webflow</b>
<b>Ease of use</b>	Relatively easy. Geared more toward the “beginner with a little bit of knowledge” end.	Easy to get started with walk-through onboarding, but the user interface is much more complex. Geared toward more experienced designers.
<b>Design elements</b>	A large number of very high-quality design elements. You can't customize these as you go, but you can choose to change templates in the middle of a design.	A large number of templates available as well as the ability to customize as you go. You can't change templates in the middle of a design.
<b>Features</b>	Has most of the features you would want with a clear focus on quality over quantity.	Huge flexibility with features. The feature set is vast, but geared toward those with knowledge. Some coding may be required for more advanced features.
<b>Support</b>	Has chat, email, knowledge base and extra tutorials.	Has email and a knowledge base.
<b>Ecommerce</b>	Supports ecommerce. More features available on the more expensive plans.	Supports ecommerce on any paid plan.
<b>Pricing</b>	Tiered, no free plan. 14 day free trial.	Tiered pricing. Free plan allows you to do everything except publish your site.
